- CD/MP3's, radios, TV's
- B-B/pellet guns
- Water balloons
- Translucent clothing

- Shaving cream
- Video games
- Fireworks or Fire arms
- Water guns
- Soccer shorts
- Volleyball shorts
- Speed-O's (oh, no!)
- Muscle shirts
- Tube tops

- Live snakes
- Dead snakes
- Play snakes
- Sticks that look like snakes
- Pictures of snakes

Packing:

- 1. Pack as efficiently as possible; "two bag rule"
- 2. Campers are **REQUIRED** to turn over their phones during the week.
- 3. Keep your stuff in your area.
- 4. Some things used for the trip to camp should remain in the buses/vans. For example, MP3's, radio's, DVD players, phones, etc. If these items are taken away, they will not be returned.
